TO: SHERIFFS, CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICERS, COMMISSIONERS OF CORRECTION, NEW YORK CITY WARDENS, FACILITY MEDICAL DIRECTORS, HEALTH SERVICE ADMINISTRATORS, AND NURSE ADMINISTRATORS

RE: Electronic Prescriptions

Effective March 27, 2015, changes to the New York State Public Health Law will require nurse practitioners, dentists, physicians, and physician assistants to issue prescriptions electronically and directly to a pharmacy. Neither e-mailed nor faxed prescriptions are considered an electronic prescription.
