TO: SHERIFFS, JAIL ADMINISTRATORS, COMMISSIONERS OF CORRECTION, AND CHIEFS OF POLICE

RE: 1999 Regional HIV Education and Training

The Commission of Correction recently received the calendar of HIV Education and Training sponsored regionally by the AIDS Institute for the period January to June 1999. There are now fifteen different programs available including three new programs as follows:

The Americans with Disabilities Act and HIV/AIDS
Rape and Sexual Abuse--Critical issues for HIV Providers and Rape Crisis Counselors
Bridging Theory and Practice: Applying Behavioral Theory to HIV/STD Prevention

You will see that some of the programs outside New York City are only offered once in the various regions of the State so registration will be limited. The programs are important for medical unit staff who provide HIV counseling and testing, but mental health providers and facility counselors will find that the topics involve many of the issues they encounter in case management.
