RE: Appointment of Donald Nadler as Deputy Director of Operations

I am pleased to announce that I have appointed Donald Nadler to the position of Deputy Director of Operations of the State Commission of Correction, effective June 17, 1999. Mr. Nadler assumes the position vacated by Robert K. Corliss, who is retiring from the Commission after 19 years of dedicated service.

Most of you know Don Nadler as a distinguished corrections professional with extensive jail managerial experience and as an innovator in efforts to professionalize corrections. He has been at the forefront of executive leadership development, training and jail management automation, among other initiatives. Don began his career as a correction officer in 1975. He worked his way up through the ranks of both the Montgomery and Fulton County Sheriff's Departments which included the conception, development, construction and transition of a new local correctional facility where none had been for many years.

The Bureau of Field Operations will report to Mr. Nadler, who will in turn report to Director of Operations Jim Lawrence. I know that Don's appointment will be well received throughout the correctional establishment and that his presence will contribute to a positive working relationship between our agencies for years to come.
